

**CELEBRATING OUR AWARD
HEALTHY COMMUNITIES COLLABORATIVE NETWORK**

We are excited to share our news that the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) has awarded Collaborative Ventures Network (CVN) a three-year grant for its Health Center Controlled Networks (HCCN) Program. Beginning August 1, 2019, this HRSA funding will enable CVN to continue providing needed training and technical assistance to the 26 health centers across Arizona and Nevada participating in its *Healthy Communities Collaborative Network* so that, both individually and together, we can better leverage Health IT to increase participation in value-based care.

As HRSA noted in its Notice of Funding Opportunity (HRSA-19-011): “Health IT can be instrumental to achieving value-based care transformation, which provides benefits including greater patient empowerment, transparency between patients and providers, and increased value and quality. In order to move towards value-based care delivery, health centers must advance data sharing and analytics capacity and develop population health management tools. HCCNs will support health centers to improve the patient and provider experience, advance interoperability, and improve data use.”

HRSA has outlined its expectations for HCCNs over the three-year grant period and set three primary Goals for the HCCN Project, scheduled to end July 31, 2022:



For each of these three HCCN Project Goals, HRSA has identified three Objectives and a related Metric against which the HCCNs can measure their contribution to advancing the overall purpose of the HCCN funding. The HCCN will support each participating health center as it strategizes and develops an Individualized Work Plan over the first 90 days of the grant period. Then, our HCCN Project Team will collaborate with, not only the participating health centers, but also HRSA’s national strategic partners, the Arizona and Nevada primary care organizations, and other national, state and local organizations to align and leverage the resources that will advance the nine HCCN Project Objectives.
